Course Objectives

- To give Electrical personnel who already have the current experience but require up-to-date knowledge of the relevant Building Regulations to gain this mandatory qualification to enable them to undertake an onsite inspection. Once both the Part P and the onsite inspection have been passed, the individual is able to register competence with appropriate awarding bodies.
- To give general installation personnel the required knowledge of building regulations to enable them to install to the approved standard prior to supervisors certifying installations.
