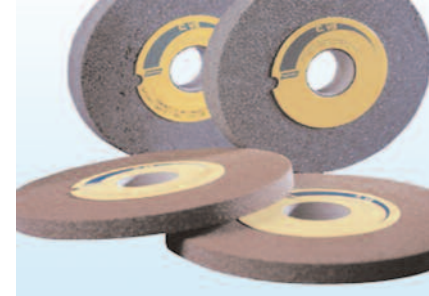


HEALTH AND SAFETY ABRASIVE WHEEL

- Hazards arising from the use of abrasive wheels and precautions that should be observed (noise, vibration, expiry dates)
- How to identify abrasive wheels as to type and characteristics
- Storing, handling and transporting abrasive wheels
- Inspecting and testing abrasive wheels
- The functions of all components used with abrasive wheels, including flanges, washers, bushes and nuts used in mounting and including knowledge of the correct and incorrect methods of assembling all components and correct balancing of abrasive wheels
- The safe changing and use of abrasive wheels
- Personal Protective Equipment
- Written and practical assessments
