Metal Processing

Metal Processing Pathway

Mandatory Units (all four units must be completed)

- MPO2/001 : Meet Safety, Health And Environment Requirements In The Workplace
- MPO2/002 : Support The Achievement Of Work Objectives
- MPO2/003 : Respond to process problems
- MPO2/004 : Support Your Own And Others' Improvements At Work

Optional Units (must complete two units from examples below)

- MPO2/009 : Prepare raw materials and equipment for processing
- MPO2/014 : Cast metals
- MPO2/015 : Prepare for heating
- MPO2/017 : Prepare plant and equipment for forming
- MPO2/018 : Form metals
- MPO2/020 : Prepare for wire and rope manufacture
- MPO2/023 : Process feedstock
- MPO2/024 : Finish metal products
- MPO2/025 : Maintain cooling systems
- MPO2/027 : Provide services on a process
- MPO2/028 : Operate the process under varying conditions
- MPO2/031 : Receive and verify goods and materials entering storage
